i. "The Meaning of Amrit Mahotsav of Independence for the Underprivileged Society" by Dr. Meena Shekhar

She explained about the present status and mindset of Indian People specially Hindus who are engaged in castiesm. The Caste is unethical, unconstitutional, and undesirable. Baba Saheb B.R Ambedkar described it as an Economic Institution. Even after 75 years of independence, the downtrodden society or so-called scheduled caste and scheduled tribes are not able to get their share in national resources. They are denied their education, their reservation, and even not paid their value to their labour. They still don't have the freedom to choose their job, not free to do what they want to do, not free to drink water from common Mataka, Their political representatives are still not free to speak within their party for their rights. They are harassed, discriminated against, face many atrocities, denied their access to genuine share, and awarded fewer marks in interviews to keep them below certain standards. They are still not enjoying the freedom they got as

per constitutions. Therefore the Amrit Mahotsav even after 75 years of independence is meaningless for them.

ii. "Relevance of the Preamble of the Constitution of India - In special reference to PBA" by Dr V.K Shekhar

The Preamble of the Constitution of India

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political; LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION

- Preamble is the Preface to the Constitution of India
- Preamble is the core Philosophy of the Constitution of India
- Preamble is the gist of the Constitution of India
- Preamble is part of the Constitution of India
- If there comes any doubt or confusion regarding the interpretation of any part or clause of the constitution, it should be interpreted in light of the preamble.

The Road Map

We must read the Constitution and remain watchful that it must be implemented by all the functionaries, executive, judiciary, and legislature; organizations, agencies offices, and officials in the country. If any provision of the Constitution is violated or abridged, one must raise our voice and make efforts to restore the supremacy of the Constitution. We must develop public opinion against violation or abridgment of the provisions of the Constitution and fight for the restoration of justice.

In elections, we must vote for the candidate who is practically the best supporter of the spirit of the Constitution.

We must ignore the characteristics regarding his religion, place of birth, economic status, social status, and personal benefits he offers in context with his election to the post.
